## VIRTUAL PLATFORM CRITICAL INFORMATION

### Welcome Tab

- **Watch the brief Welcome Video.** It has important housekeeping notes.

### Agenda, Presentation and Handouts tab

- Review the session times. All session times are listed in the **Central Time Zone**.
- Download handouts.
- Sessions will air live at designated times.
- Log in to your first session 15 to 30-minutes early and subsequent sessions as early as possible to ensure you have no issues.
  - Tech support is available and information for contacting them is on the virtual platform website.
- Recordings will be available to watch for 30 days post conference.
  - **EXCEPTION:** The Cyber Fraud recording cannot be made available after the conference. If you miss the live airing, watch the recording that evening.

### CES® and MCLE Tab
